4. Lead Paint

In order to comply with the United States Environmental Protection Agency's Renovation, Repair and Painting Program Rule, the Central Curry School District 1 will only contract with certified lead based paint renovation contractors licensed by the Oregon Construction Contractors Board.

5. Asbestos

Central Curry School District 1 complies with the federal Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA). The most recent assessment was completed in September 2018 and will be completed again every three years. All required asbestos management plans are available for viewing by submitting a request to Tim Wilson, Superintendent.

6. Radon
